Mr. Warren spoke about the growth of this organization of security services of the Southern cone countries and of accompanying disturbing developments in its operational attitudes. Originally designed as a communications system and data bank to facilitate defense against the guerrilla Revolutionary Coordinating Junta, the organization was emerging as one with a far more activist role, including specifically that of identifying, locating, and guerrilla leaders. This was an understandable reaction to the increasingly extra-national, extreme, and effective range of the Junta's activities. Reasonable or not, however, it was bound to complicate CIA's relations with the security services involved; requests from them for information about individuals, for example, would have to be handled by the Agency far more gingerly than had been the case before this development.
